Language and Communication

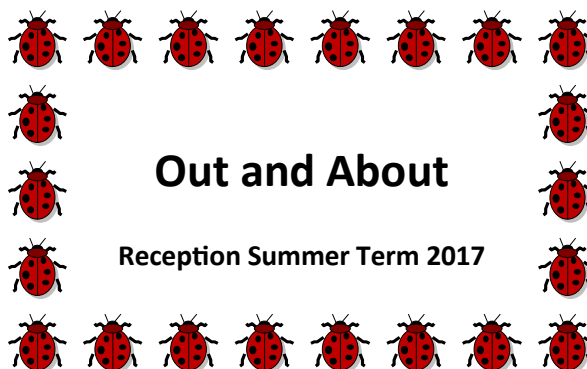
Listen attentively in group situations

Count, recognise, order and write numbers to 20
Order numbers to 20 saying which is one more and one less—make a game
Add and subtract two single digit numbers
Halving and doubling—ladybirds spots
Name and know some properties of 2D and 3D shapes

Understanding the World

Know some similarities and differences between different cultures and families
Observe and talk about change—melting butter, growing seeds, similarities and differences between different mini beasts
Completes a simple program on the computer

Expressive Arts and Design

Sing songs, make music and dance—creepy crawly assembly
Construct models with a purpose in mind
Mix paints and materials—make pebble ladybirds, paper mache bugs, observational drawing of wildlife area
Introduce a narrative into their role play
