So far we have had about £1,000 of sponsorship money which is a great effort, but please keep



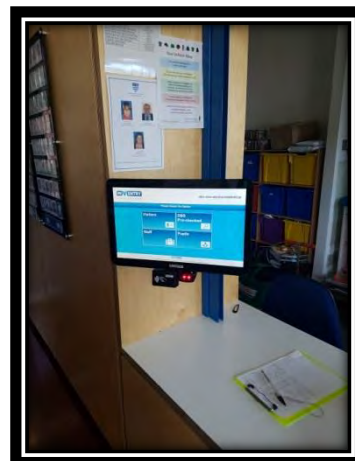
collecting and handing in. All money will go to our outdoor learning environment and sports areas.

## NEW ENTRY SYSTEM

We have a new sign in system called **InVentry** that will add to our safeguarding procedures at school. It will improve our system of knowing who is in the building, checking visitors and their DBS status and recording when children arrive at school or leave for appointments. When you visit the school [maybe to support in class for example] you will have to enter your details on a touch screen and a pass will be printed for you. When you leave you will have to 'check out'.

Children who arrive after registration time will have to check in as well or, if they are picked up late after school will have to be checked out.

We plan to fully implement this after half-term but are 'practising' with it going forward.

#### PIANO

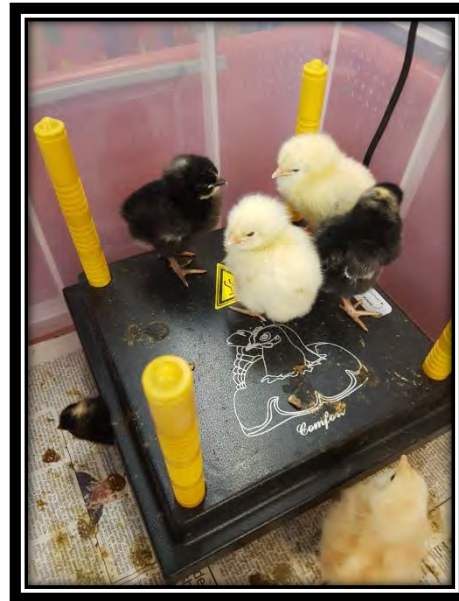
Congratulations to Ruoshui for passing his grade 4 piano exam with distinction, a great achievement.
