Poster top tips - let's get creative

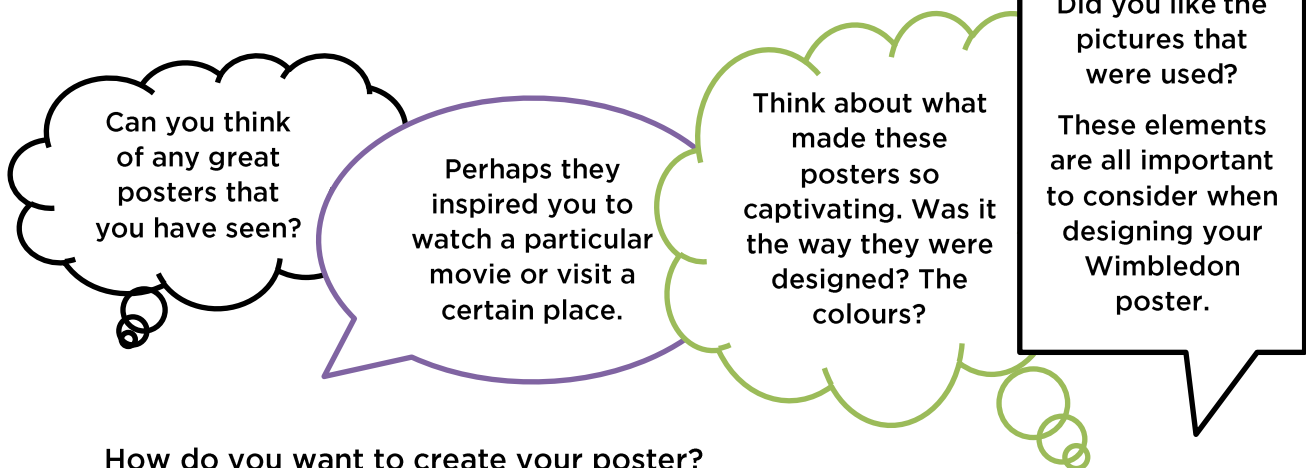
What is a mind map?
