MASCULINE or FEMININE?



Unlike English, French nouns are either **MASCULINE** or **FEMININE**. This is known as the **GENDER**.

You can tell the gender of a noun by the words for 'a' and 'the' :

a = un (masculine)
 une (feminine)

the = le (masculine)
 la (feminine)
