The format of the discussions will be slightly different to parent consultations in normal times. The main focus will be an opportunity for you and the teachers to discuss how your child is managing with remote learning or critical worker provision, how their well-being can be supported as well as their learning progress.

A suggested format of the discussions are attached.

For all classes, except Sparrows, on Friday 26th February, remote learning will be set but there will be no live sessions that day. Similarly, on Friday 5th March there will be no live lessons for Sparrows but remote learning will be set.

For parents of children with Individual Education Support Plans, we will ensure that there will be another meeting to discuss the plans after the children return to school.
