WINTER HEALTH

You may be aware from the news recently, of the Government's drive to increase children's attendance at school to get it back to prepandemic levels. This includes reassuring parents that children can come to school with **minor colds and coughs**. We spoke to the children in assembly about the importance of washing hands and other hygiene practices to keep us all healthy through the winter months.

The main advice is:

- children are encouraged to stay in education or childcare with symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat or slight cough (if otherwise well and do not have a high temperature).
- if a child has a fever and is unwell, they should stay home from school or nursery until the fever has passed and they are well enough to attend.
- if a child has diarrhoea and/or vomiting, they should stay off school or nursery for at least 48 hours after their symptoms clear up this will help stop the spread of stomach bugs.










PUNCTUALITY
