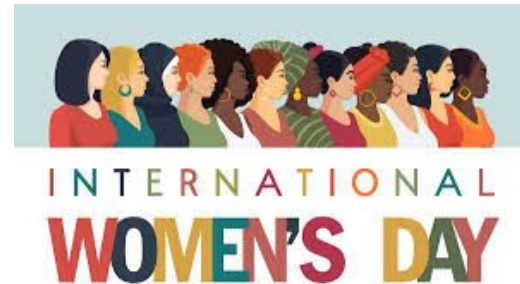

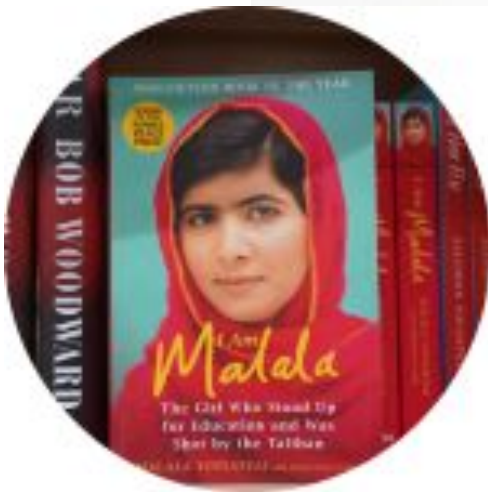
Emma Watson
