Multiplication Times Tables Check

In June all Year 4 children across the country will be completing a Multiplication Times Tables Check. The check has been in place for the past two years. The check is taken by the children online and lasts about 5 minutes. There are 25 questions and the children will have 6 seconds to input the answer. We will practise how to complete the test in the coming weeks.

We have been working hard on our times tables and it is important the children continue this at home. Timestables Rockstars is an excellent resource for this and we encourage the children to use it.
